Saturday 1st May 2010

Venue:

Central Pool, Reading - 25 metre, 6 lane, manual timing, anti-turbulence lane ropes.

Age Groups:

10 years and under, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15 years and over at 1st May 2010.

Events Offered:

100m Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly, Freestyle, IM and 50m Freestyle - all age groups.

Format of events:

All events will be decided on heat times. There will be no finals. Heats will be seeded in entry time order regardless of age, i.e. Heat one is for the slowest accepted entries or entries with no time. Heats will be spearheaded.

The ONE START RULE will apply to this meet. In order to ensure the events run to time OVER THE TOP starts will operate.

Time cards will not be used. This will be run as a cardless meet.

Entry Fees:

Entry fees are £4.00 per swim.

Coaches' Passes:

Coaches' Passes for poolside access for the meet will cost £7.00 This fee includes a full set of programmes, results and refreshments between sessions.

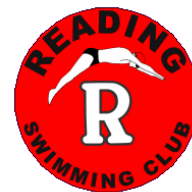
Technical Officials:

Entries:

Entries should be made on the official entry form attached. Photocopies of entry forms will be accepted. Submitted times should be current best times for a 25m pool. Completed entry forms must be returned, together with the appropriate entry fee to Reading Swimming Club, 15 Milldown Avenue, Goring on Thames, Reading, RG8 0AS, Berkshire. Enquiries should be directed by e-mail to Info@readingswimclub.org.

Reading Swimming Club reserves the right to restrict entries, on the basis of submitted times, principally to ensure completion of sessions within planned times. In the event of the meet being over subscribed, the fastest swimmers in each age group will be accepted until the event is full.

The entry fee is £4.00 per event. Remittances should be made payable to Reading Swimming Club and crossed. Club entries are to be accompanied by one cheque for the requisite sum, rather than a number of smaller cheques.

The closing date for entries is Thursday 1st April 2010, but entries before that date would be appreciated.

After the closing date for entries, list of accepted and rejected entries will be returned, together with details of signing in, warm-up, meet instructions and refunds in respect of unaccepted entries. Please enclose a SAE address for the return of this information. If a suitable electronic address has been provided, the information will be sent by e-mail, instead of by post.
